

BRIEF HISTORY OF THE NAIROBI NATIONAL POLYTECHNIC

The Nairobi National Polytechnic derives its history as far back as the year 1951 when it started as "Modern High School", catering predominantly for the Asian community residents in the neighbourhood. Though a secondary school, the curriculum offered at the time had a bias towards the inculcation of vocational skills, which encompassed Mechanical Engineering and Carpentry & Joinery. In 1953, the name of the school was changed to Technical High School and the Cambridge School Certificate Examination was first taken in 1954.

At independence and in the spirit of the Ominde Educational Commission of 1964, the school opened its doors to all races. The curriculum continued to emphasize on Technical Education and was expanded to include Plant Mechanical, Woodwork, Electrical and Motor Vehicle mechanics skills. Both 'O' and 'A' level classes were accommodated.

With the implementation of the Mackay report in 1984, all Technical High Schools in the country were converted to Technical Training Institutes to admit and equip high school leavers with vocational skills. Nairobi Technical Training Institute came into being and initially offered courses at artisan level. These courses comprised General Fitter, Welding and Fabrication, Carpentry and Joinery, Electrical Installation Motor Vehicle Mechanics and Business Studies.

After an appraisal of the Institute, Craft courses were introduced in 1988 and these included Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Installation, Motor Vehicle Mechanics, Science Laboratory Technology, Supplies Management and KATC. Enrolment into Carpentry and Joinery continued to dwindle and the course was eventually phased out and replaced with Garment Making in 1995.

Applied Biology was launched in 1995 as the first diploma level program. This marked the beginning of the introduction of a wide array of programs in various fields at Diploma level, the latest being Food and Beverage, Pharmacy and Information Communication Technology.

The institute was upgraded to the status of a National Polytechnic in February 2025.

The Polytechnic is registered vide Certificate of Registration and legal order number 34 of 2025.

To Provide Competent Graduates in Technical, Vocational Research and Innovation for the Global Market.

OUR MANDATE

To Provide Technical and Vocational Education and Training that focus on Skills Development, Curriculum Development, Certification, Industry Partnerships, Research, and Lifelong Learning as Contained in the Technical and Vocational Education and Training Act, 2013.

The Nairobi National Polytechnic is a public tertiary institution under the Ministry of Education, State Department of Vocational and Technical Training. The Polytechnic receives full support from the Government through grants, training equipment and personnel.

The Government has continually funded infrastructure development in various fields including Health and Applied Sciences, which is our Centre of Excellence. Currently the Polytechnic is expanding existing Science laboratories to accommodate the ultra-modern equipment received from African Development Bank (ADB) through the GOK.

In addition, it has also funded the construction of a new Information Communication Technology Centre which is equipped with modern training facilities. In collaboration with the government of the Netherlands, the Directorate is undertaking an intensive training for lecturers and refurbishment of engineering departments so that they can offer market driven courses using modern equipment and technology.

The government has funded the construction of Engineering Workshops and Laboratories under the Economic Stimulus Implementation Programme which will help improve on the Engineering Training Services for the realization of Vision 2030.

The Polytechnic is registered with the Kenya Universities and Colleges Central Placement Services (KUCCPS) which places students for various Diploma courses offered in the Institute. Upon placement, the Institute issues joining instructions to the successful applicants. Applications are sent directly to the placement body through KUCCPS website: (<https://student.kuccps.net/>)

The Ministry of Education has approved training in Higher National Diploma in the following courses: HND in Human Resource Management, HND in Food Science Technology (Quality control) and HND in Electrical Engineering (Power Option)

The Polytechnic operates under a Quality Management System (QMS) that has enabled maintenance of high levels of performance. This has led to the Certification on **ISO 9001:2015** Quality Standards by the Kenya Bureau of Standards.

VISION, MISSION & MANDATE

The Polytechnic has established collaboration with German Agency for International Cooperation (GIZ), the University of Nairobi in the area of Health and Applied Sciences in capacity building for the teaching staff, Training partnership with Samsung Electronics through Samsung Engineering Academy for the training of Electrical and Electronic Engineering Diploma students and Training of Solar PV Technicians in collaboration with Kenya Renewable Energy Association (KERA) and Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA)

Levels of Training: We admit students under three main levels namely;

Level 3 : Entry requirement is usually a KCPE certificate and above. On qualification at this level students can progress to the next level of Artisan certificate.

Level 4 (Artisan Courses): Entry requirement is usually a KCSE Certificate and above. On qualifying at this level students can progress to the next level of Craft Certificate.

Level 5 (Craft Certificate Courses): Minimum entry requirement to these courses is usually a KCSE mean grade D (plain) for Module One and PASS for Module Two. Upon completion of Certificate Courses, students can proceed to Diploma Courses.

Level 6 (Diploma Courses): Entry requirements at this level is usually a KCSE mean grade C- (minus) and different cluster subjects for different courses.
